Call for Videos

We call upon women and their allies to voice support for this international campaign led by the United Nations. It runs from **November 25, 2019 (International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women) to December 10, 2019 (Human Rights Day)**.

How to participate:

1. **Create a 1-minute video to express support for women and gender minorities at risk of gender-based violence.** Ideas: draw on the UN theme for this year’s campaign which is “[Orange the World: Fund, Respond, Prevent, Collect!](#)”, the City of Nanaimo’s renewed [Proclamation](#), or say what is needed to eliminate gender-based violence.
2. **Share the video through a file-sharing program** such as Google Drive, DropBox, or MS One Drive and send it to womenactnanaimo@gmail.com **by November 20, 2020**. We recommend file-sharing because there can be technical issues with video-based email attachments. Please email us if you need technical assistance. Use the **subject line: 16 Days Video Submission** and include your first and last name in the email.
3. **Share video links during 16 Days of Activism.** Videos will be posted on YouTube and can be shared on social media. Links will also be available on the VIUFA home page.
